## **Year 6 Spanish Excursion**

This week on Monday, 3rd of September, the year 6 students went on an excursion to South Sydney High School to make empanadas and clay skulls. We were split into two groups; one went to make empanadas whilst the other group was doing the clay skulls.

Working in the art room, we were told about the Spanish tradition the Day of the Dead. This is a celebration throughout Mexico where citizens spread yellow flowers from the graveyards to their homes in hope that their passed loved ones will return from their graves. We moulded the skulls from clay and designed it until we were satisfied. The skulls were kept at the school whilst they dried and get baked in the kiln. Next week, they should be returned to us and ready for painting.

In the kitchens, we made special empanadas called "Tres Hermanas," meaning the Three Sisters. We learned that the Three Sisters gardening is a method of companion planting developed in South America many years ago. The seeds of corn, beans and squash are planted together and as they grow the bean vines climb the corn stalks, while the squash covers the soil with living green mulch. Therefore to make the Empanadas we combined Cheese, Beans, Corn and Pumpkin for the filling and placed one spoon on to the pastry. We then folded and sealed the pastry and placing them into the oven. After 15 minutes, boom the empanadas were done. The Spanish excursion was a great experience and a very enlightening one.
