My grandma, Parvaneh Roudgar participated in the Sculptures by the Sea this year. Her sculpture was called Migration. She got the idea when she migrated from Florence, Italy to Vancouver, Canada. She had a home in front of the ocean where you could hear the Canadian Geese, which she could tell they just migrated too. That is why she made the sculpture, as a symbol of their journey and a sense of common achievement, almost like a bond with the birds. As you can see, she did not make the sculpture look exactly like Geese as she made the neck longer and spread out their wings to make them look proud, as this is how she felt. However, the main reason the sculpture does not look exactly like a family of geese is because she did not want to make the sculpture about geese but about a concept: migration and family.

Ministers Language Award 2018 to MBPS student

On Monday 29 November 2018 Lewis N in class 4S attended the NSW Minister's Awards for Excellence in Student Achievement, NSW Community Language Schools, at UNSW. Lewis has been selected by a jury of the NSW Community Language Schools committee and received the Highly Commended Award – Junior, in the Swedish language. This year, 244 students were nominated from 29 different languages and 19 students received the highly commended junior award.

About language schools

The Saturday School of Community Languages, a NSW Department of Education school, has been operating since 1978. Many of the students in this program continue their study for the Higher School Certificate. At moment, there are 36,288 students studying in NSW Community Languages Schools Program. Chinese, Arabic, Vietnamese, Greek, Korean, Tamil and Japanese have the greatest number of students studying in community language schools in 2018. The Swedish School in Sydney has 150 students studying in after school hours in public schools with qualified teacher. The focus is to improve language skills and maintain culture.

Key Learning Areas - History/Geography, PDHPE , Creative Arts and Science

History/Geography, PDHPE and Creative Arts

This term Kindergarten has been learning about our local environment and beach safety. We are so lucky that we live so close to Maroubra Beach. We spoke about the importance of swimming between the flags and what makes Maroubra Beach so unique. KV was inspired to make a piece of artwork. We hope you enjoy our creativity.



Science

The class investigated what things are made of. In particular we looked at two sponges. One was a sea sponge and one was a kitchen sponge (brand new of course!). Students used their senses of sight, touch, smell and hearing (no tasting). Students came up with their own inquiry questions and hypothesised whether one sponge was better or more efficient than the other. Students shared their observations and ideas. They identified that objects are made of materials that have observable properties. This led to a discussion on natural and man-made resources. We even compared both sponges under the microscope.
