Welcome to 2019

Students in Kindergarten will have their Best Start assessments on Wednesday, Thursday or Friday and then all Kindergarten students will start on Monday 4 February at 9.00am.

New Classes

With thanks to our teachers, classes have been formed and are ready to go for this year. We will be having an assembly at 9am on Tuesday 30 January for all students in Years 1 to 6. 2019 classes and teachers will be announced and parents can see where their child will be learning for the new year.

We will be monitoring new enrolments and students that have not returned and trust that this new class structure can remain in place.
