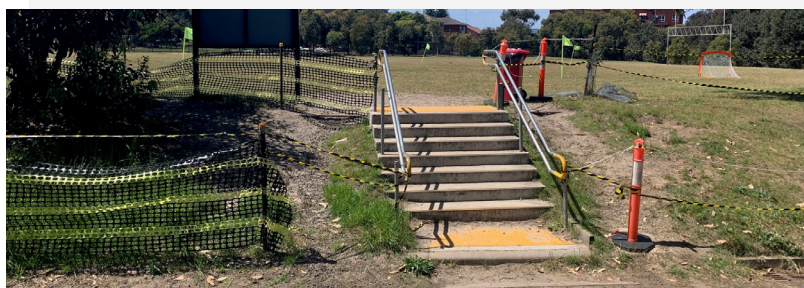
## OSHC (Out of School Hours Care) Tender

Over the past 12 months, our school has been receiving advice from Asset Services in the Department of Education about the proper procedure for renewing our OSHC agreement. The current (5 year) agreement expired in July this year. During this time, the community has been updated through newsletter and P&C meeting updates. The school has also had many meetings with our current service provider, Maroubra Bay Care Centre. At the same time, the Department's tender processes have been on hold for most of the year pending the outcome of a review. The review is now complete and over the holidays we were informed that our OSHC service will be going to tender this term.

I would like to assure parents that there will be no disruption to our before and after care services during this tender process, which will be completed by the end of the term. The new agreement will start on the first day of term one next year.

As part of the tender selection process, an Asset Services manager will assist as a non-voting panel member. In addition, the Principal will be the convener with a class teacher representing the staff on the panel. There will also be two members of the community on the panel to ensure the community views are represented. Hardly surprising given the wide scope of Jewish topics covered. These include Jewish Festivals, Values and Ethics, as well as exploring some age appropriate areas of Jewish History. Key Learning Areas as well as child-centred learning practices are incorporated into each lesson. Each lesson is supplemented with a coloured, engaging workbook and on occasion students will receive giveaways. Each term BJE emails registered parents the curriculum outline.*

# HALLOWEEN!!!

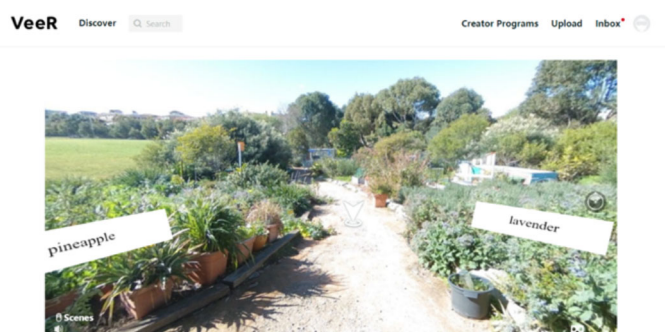
