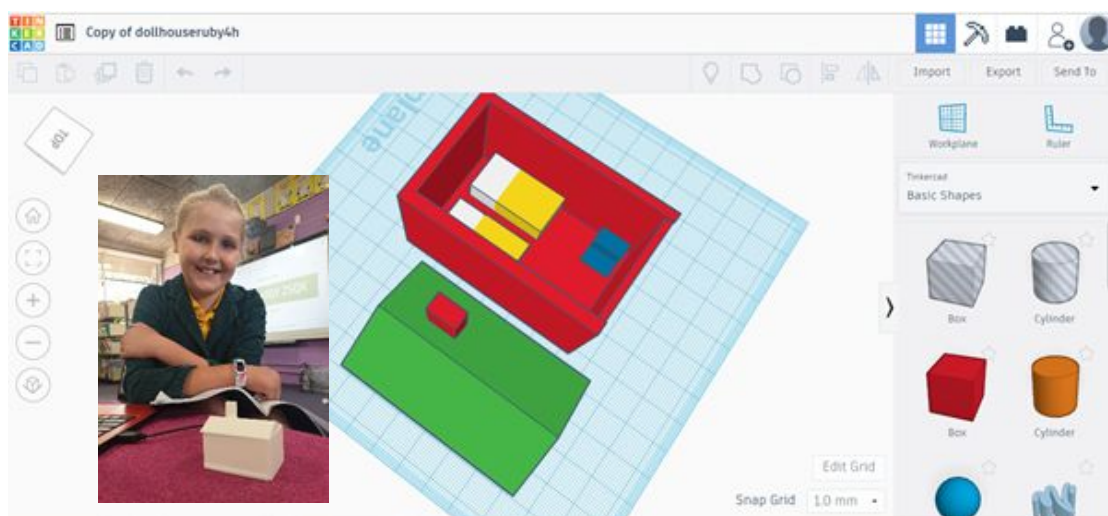
Staff Changes 2020

3D Printing at Maroubra Bay

This term, students in years 3-6 have been learning 3D design and 3D printing. Students were tasked with imagining and designing a new toy using CAD (Computer Aided Design) software called Tinkercad. After considering the restrictions associated with material extrusion 3D printing (talk to your child about 'overhang'!), students have been printing their designs using the 3D printer currently on loan to us from the DoE 'Stemshare' program. The unit of work has culminated with brief student presentation of their product, complete with a marketing direction that would make this product appealing to children their age.

Students and staff have been really impressed how their abstract ideas can be transformed into solid reality. It's an eye-opening project that exemplifies the sort of design and production processes so important to both Science and Technology syllabuses, and of course, the greater world beyond.

Our Mural

As you make your way through the front gates, you would have noticed that our mural is taking shape. The mural is being painted by local Koori artist Garry Purchase. Garry has been responsible for a number of murals in the local area, most recently La Perouse PS. Once completed the mural will be a wonderful way of welcoming students, parents, carers and visitors to our school.

About the artist

Garry is a proud Aboriginal man of Dharawal, Bidjigal and Dhungutti decent. He grew up in Sydney's Eastern suburbs in Botany and was raised amongst the Aboriginal community of La Perouse.

Garry is a member of the Timbery family of which there are many famous members. He is the Great Great Great Great Grandson of Timbery (Or Timberé), leader of the Dharawal people and was bestowed the title "King Of The Five Islands" by Governor Lachlan Macquarie. Garry is also The Great Great Grandson of Queen Emma Timbery and a cousin of Esme Timbery who are both internationally renowned for their artistic shell work. His great uncle is Joe Timbery, world champion boomerang thrower who also presented one to Queen Elizabeth II in 1954.

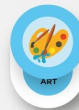

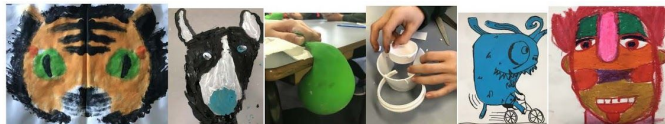
