Don't forget to bring your Library bag

Most students are disappointed when they don't get to borrow a book on their library day. That's why recently we have been allowing students to borrow books even without a library bag. We hope you have enjoyed sharing these books at home with your children.

Afternoon Pick-up Changes

If you have changes to your child's afternoon pick-up arrangements on the day please phone the school office on 9349 1569 as early as possible preferably before 1pm or if you know before school of changes please send a note with your child to the classroom teacher. Please don't send emails as technology can sometimes be down or the email has not been seen in time.

Change of Address, Phone Number and contacts

Please notify the office in writing asap if you have changed your address, phone numbers or your emergency contacts.

Student Medications

It is very important that the school has the required up to date documentation from your child's Doctor if they have Asthma or Anaphylaxis, which is their Action Plans. The school needs to have the students Ventolin and Epi-Pen that are in date. Please make sure to bring in replacement medications before they expire to the office.

If your child is unwell and needs medication for a short period only medications that are on a Prescription from the Doctor with your child's name on it and is current can be administered by the school staff. You will need to give the medication to the office and fill out and sign a Medication permission form.

Children are not to keep medications in their bags in the classrooms.
