## NEW Return dates!

The Premier has today announced changes to the staggered return to school for students in NSW.

- ☐ Week 2 - 11 October - School only open for families who need it, all other students learning from home.
- ☐ Week 3 - 18 October - school open for all Kindergarten and Year 1 students, plus any other families that need it.
- ☐ Week 4 - 25 October - school open for all students K-6.

These are important changes, and we hope that our families can support these return to school plans.

Please note classroom teachers will be back teaching their classes as per these dates, ie Kindergarten and Year 1 teachers on 18 October and all other classes on 25 October.

Whilst I know there will be some hesitancy in the community, we strongly encourage all students to return to school on these dates. Our teachers are really looking forward to reconnecting and returning to what we know best.

An update on our projects at school;

- ☐ Operable walls in Year 3 and Kindergarten - all engineered work complete, doors ordered and installation in November.
- ☐ Playground upgrade - site has been surveyed and a tender process is currently being arranged. Work is expected to be completed by the middle of next year.
- ☐ A Block and Hall roof - currently working on replacing the A Block (Year 3 and 4 building) and Hall with a colourbond roof, no date of completion at this stage
- ☐ Air conditioning - the remaining 3 classrooms without air conditioning have been scheduled for term one 2022 installation.

Other projects being investigated for upcoming works;

- ☐ Fixing driveway water runoff issue into the garden space with a new driveway
- ☐ Replacing many cupboards and sinks in classroom wet areas that are damaged and missing
- ☐ Replacing cupboards, benches and sinks in the Canteen
- ☐ Painting and upgrading main toilet block
