Term 4 Roadmap

Car parking concerns

A reminder that the area out the front of the top Gate 1 is now a Bus bay between the hours of 7.00am-9.15am as well as 2.30pm and 4.15pm. Whilst this area may appear to be empty, be aware that parking or stopping here is an offence and Council Rangers or NSW Police can book drivers.

The area out of the front of the main Gate 2 is now all Kiss and Go parking between the hours of 8.00am-9.30am and 2.30pm-4.00pm. During these times drivers are allowed to stop and drop off or pick up students. The length of stay should be less than 2 minutes and drivers should not leave their vehicle.

A further reminder that if the Kiss and Go area is full of cars, parents and carers should continue and complete a further lap. By stopping on the other side of the pedestrian crossing you are making it dangerous for students and families crossing the road.

Outside of these hours listed, both areas are free to park for all parents and carers.

Student safety comes first, thank you to all our parents and carers for supporting these changes.
