Winter School Sport

School Sport also begins in Week 4 for all students in Stage 2 and Stage 3. Students will engage in game based rotations weekly where they will have the opportunity to apply the skills acquired in our Sports Pro lessons. Watch this space to see what we get up to each week.

Term 2 Sports Pro Programs

This term each stage has a new focus for our lessons. Kindergarten are focusing on building their fundamental movement skill acquisition and apply this to minor games. Students participate in structured 'skill based' drills, repeating movement patterns until they become competent in performing the desired technique before playing some fun and challenging games. Year 1 are engaging in games based learning where students will be given the opportunity to play in small sided and modified games which encompass some of the skills that they have been exposed to during the term. Years 2-6 are learning more about softball, oz-tag, netball and soccer with specific coaching on the skills for each sport. Each of these programs are derived from the PD/H/PE syllabus outcomes and enquiry questions supplementing our class programs.

Zone Cross Country Carnival

This Friday we have 32 of our cross country runners, attending the ESPSSA Zone Cross Country Carnival where they will compete against the 14 other schools in our network. This team is comprised of the four fastest runners in each age division. They are very excited! We are also very excited, especially because this event was cancelled last year due to COVID-19. 
